**II. Discussion / Action Items:**

Update: 2009 Home Tour: Cynthia Menna reported that:

- The tour to occur on Sunday, December 6<sup>th</sup> from 1PM – 5PM
- There are currently 10 homes scheduled for the home tour. Cynthia has indicated that a few extra homes could be added
- Tickets will be \$10 in advance and \$12 at the door. Advance tickets will be sold at Dee's Hallmark, Village Antiques and Campbell's Paint and Wallpaper. Advance tickets can also be obtained by calling Susan Clark. Ticket info to be forwarded to Rick Nevau to post to the district web site
- Tour to start at the Good Shepherd United Methodist Church (Mason and Monroe). Because of the distance from the neighborhood, the committee will look at using a shuttle service. A shuttle from Entertainment Express would cost \$570. Other alternatives will also be investigated including Village Ford (possible use of their customer shuttle) and the City of Dearborn (senior housing shuttle, donated by Kiwanis Club). Also, the issue of additional insurance for the district will be investigated by the home tour committee if a shuttle service is used.
- Ads will be sold within the tour booklet to offset the costs associated with running the event.
- The Kiwanis Club of Dearborn has donated \$300 to the district for this event. An ad will be placed within the tour booklet for the Kiwanis Club
- Committee informing other historical neighborhoods as well a Ford historical groups and local museums in order to sell group tickets.
- Custom district ornaments highlighting the 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the district will be made and will be sold during the event.
- The Detroit News Homestyle magazine has indicated that they can include information on the tour on the inside cover "Welcome Mat". They may also be able to include an entire article on the district.

- Gary Henderson and Danielle Bergeron to be featured on local cable TV's "Kiwanis Talk" to talk about the home tour.
- First participating home owner meeting scheduled for Monday, October 12<sup>th</sup>.
